# To Connect a Mac

- **1.** Press the "On" button on the wall controller.
- 2. Press the "laptop" button on the wall controller.
- 3. Plug your laptop into the HDMI cable (there should be a MAC adapter attached).
- 4. Use the wall controller to adjust the volume.

# To get the sound to come out through the TV, you may need to adjust your laptop settings.

**Open System Preferences and Click Sound** 



#### Click the Output tab and select HDMI.

• FYI: while HDMI is connected and selected, the volume controls on your laptop will not work- just use the TV volume.



### If the top of your Mac screen is getting cut off on the TV image:
